





Georgian Villa

Once the centre of a 2000 acre estate and built for Robert Power, High Sheriff of Kildare, in the first part of the 18th century, Burtown House is marked on early maps as Power's Grove.





Heritage Gardens

The gardens at Burtown are made up of several areas, including large herbaceous borders, shrubberies, a rock garden, a yew walk divided by a pergola, a sundial garden, a walled kitchen garden, an old orchard, a more formal stable yard garden and a large woodland garden surrounded on all sides by water.





Stable Yard House

Decorated in James and Jo's unique style, it's a beautiful, characterful house full of family art and antiques. With a high-ceilinged dining room, once the mare's stable and a super comfy sitting room, the house is spacious and lightfilled.





Parklands

There are over 12 acres of gardens, park and woodlands along with 180 acres of farmland that is currently being developed into parkland.





Green Barn Restaurant

The Green Barn combines large open spaces with high ceilings and expansive wall spaces, with movable panelled partitions to create spaces within spaces.
